- Grand Scholarship: \$500 that can be used for tuition, fees, and books.
- **Deadline:** Saturday, June 1, 2019 No Exceptions
- Requirements:
 - 1. Must be attending college in the Fall of 2019.
 - 2. Must demonstrate community service involvement (a letter confirming service is required)
 - a. Extra points will be awarded for involvement in the Back of the Yards community and/or St. Joseph Parish. A letter confirming service is required.
 - 3. Application must be complete and signed.
 - 4. Letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.
 - 5. All three essays must be included with this application. These are three separate individual one page essays.
 - 6. Copy of most current school transcripts. Unofficial transcripts can be accepted.
 - 7. If student is awarded this scholarship, he or she must submit confirmation of the university or college he or she will be attending in the Fall of 2019. Examples are: class schedule, confirmation of registration payment, and housing confirmation.
 - 8. Past HOPE Scholarship winners will NOT be considered.
