

St. Joseph's HOPE Scholarship SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM 2020

- Grand Scholarship: \$500 that can be used for tuition, fees, and books.
- **Deadline:** Monday, June 15, 2020
- Requirements:
 - 1. Must be attending college in the Fall of 2020.
 - 2. Must demonstrate community service involvement (a letter confirming service is required)
 - a. Extra points will be awarded for involvement in the Back of the Yards community and/or St. Joseph Parish. A letter confirming service is required.
 - 3. Application must be complete and signed.
 - 4. Letter of recommendation from a teacher or counselor.
 - 5. All three essays must be included with this application. These are three separate individual one page essays.
 - 6. Copy of most current school transcripts. Unofficial transcripts can be accepted.
 - 7. If student is awarded this scholarship, he or she must submit confirmation of the university or college he or she will be attending in the Fall of 2020. Examples are: class schedule, confirmation of registration payment, and housing confirmation.
 - 8. Past HOPE Scholarship winners will NOT be considered.

- 4. Back of the Yards and other inner city communities are regularly in the news for violence and gang activity. What do you think can be done by young adults like yourself and your peers to change that negative portrayal of these communities?
